## Program Assessment

There will be times you need to assess the success of a specific offering (for example, a class, gathering, or an event). Here are examples of questions that you can use as well as suggestions of who and how to ask.

*Who should you ask?*

- Participants or learners
- Teachers
- Staff and church leaders
- Yourself!

*How will you ask?*

- Paper survey [Provide PDFs of questions below.]
- Google form [Create and provide links.]
- In person meeting

### Participants or Learners Questions

- What were your favorite and least favorite parts?
- Did you enjoy the experience? What would have made it more enjoyable?
- What is one thing you learned that will make a difference in your life or faith?
- What is one thing you learned that you will be able to use in the future?

### Teachers or Class/Event Leaders Questions

- Did you understand what you were asked to accomplish?
- Is there anything you needed and didn't have that would have made your job easier or the class/event more successful?
- Were the program and the resources well organized? How could they be improved?
- What went well? What could have been better?
- What were your favorite and least favorite parts?
- Would you volunteer again?

### Christian Educators and CE Committees Questions

- Review your original goals.
  - What did you hope the participants would learn?
  - What was the class/event supposed to accomplish?
- Do you think it met your goal(s)?
- Do you think you reached the intended audience? Did it have an impact on their faith? What do you think they learned?
- What would you repeat?
