

TEACHING METHODS Music

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR IN-PERSON TEACHING:

- A PLAYLIST OF SONGS RELATED TO THE TOPIC OF DISCUSSION
- SONG LYRICS PRINTED
- CELL/COMPUTER/TABLE T WITH INTERNET ACCESS
- SPEAKERS

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR VIRTUAL TEACHING:

PLAYLIST OF SONGS
 THAT HAVE MUSIC
 VIDEOS WITH THE
 LYRICS ON THE SCREEN

EMPOWERING LEARNING:

- MULTI-SENSORY ENGAGEMENT
- ABILITY TO BE APPROPRIATE FOR ALL AGES AND ALL GROUP SIZES
- VIRTUAL COMPONENT CAN BE DONE IN REAL TIME WITH THOSE IN PERSON
- CAN MAKE COMPLEX IDEAS MORE ACCESSIBLE

DESCRIPTION

Music can be a powerful method that uses sound to engage students emotionally, physically, and mentally to help in creating a focused learning environment via multi-sensory expireneces.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR IN-PERSON TEACHING

Play a song from the playlist and ask the participants to follow along with the lyrics. Afterward, discuss what was heard and how it relates to or contradicts the topic or scripture(s) that are being highlighted. Does the song remind the participants of any other scripture? Repeat for other music selections on the playlist.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VIRTUAL TEACHING

Play a lyric video from the play list and repeat the process from the in-person teaching instructions

IDEAS FOR USING THIS METHOD

- Option to be done simultaneously in person and virtually
- Music selections can be varied by many parameters.
- As a teaching method can be used as a whole lesson or as an addition to a lesson easily.
