



TEACHING METHODS

Podcast

MATERIALS NEEDED FOR

IN-PERSON TEACHING:

- PAPER AND PENCILS
- LAPTOPS, TABLETS, IPADS OR SMART PHONES
- BIBLE
- SAMPLE PODCAST

VIRTUAL TEACHING:

- BIBLE
- GOOGLE ACCOUNT
- SAMPLE PODCAST
- SMART PHONES, TABLETS, LAPTOPS
- RECORDING APP

EMPOWERING LEARNING:

DESCRIPTION

A process oriented method in which learners will use story and sounds to create a narrative or to retell a story or event.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR IN-PERSON TEACHING

- Retell a Bible story using a Podcast as media.
- Read a passage of scripture together.
- Break into small groups of 2 or 3 and organize a retelling of the biblical story.
- Groups write scripts and choose to add sound effects and music for their Podcast. Put a time limit of recording time between 5 to 10 minutes.
- Have the groups share their Podcasts with the group.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VIRTUAL TEACHING

- Retell a Bible story using a Podcast as media.
- Read a passage of scripture together.
- Break into breakout groups of 2 or 3 and organize a retelling of the biblical story. Use Zoom for this.
- Groups write scripts using google forms and choose to add sound effects and music. Place a time limit of the recording between 5 to 10 minutes.
- Have groups share their Podcasts with the group.
- This lesson can be over a span of a couple weeks.
- Record the podcast through audacity and post it using loom for your group.

IDEAS FOR USING THIS METHOD

- Choose a professional Podcast that is a topic or interview to listen to that can lead to discussion in light of learners faith.
- Create a Podcast that interviews the congregation to witness their faith to the community.
- Create a Podcast to document transformation on a mission trip and share with the congregation.
- Create a Podcast to record Faith Statements of Confirmands and their mentors.
