DESCRIPTION

This I Believe is a teaching method utilizing short essays to express the core values that guide a student's life.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR IN-PERSON TEACHING

Utilize a slideshow to share each step of the process:

- 1. Share examples of personal philosophy statements from a variety of people
- 2. Ask the students to compose their own personal philosophy statement.
- 3. Freewrite about their statement: why does this matter? what does it say about you? what life experiences back up your statement?
- 4. Flesh the statement out into a short essay

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VIRTUAL TEACHING

Virtually teaching this method would mimic in person teaching, with the exception of needing to screenshare the slideshow.

IDEAS FOR USING THIS METHOD

- Introduce the method to confirmands as preparation for writing their faith statements
- Form a retreat for high school youth, college students, or young adults around the teaching method: how do beliefs change over time? How have the experiences in their lives impacted their beliefs?
