EMPOWERING LEARNING:

- ENGAGES SIGHT, AUDITORY, TOUCH, HEARING, INTRAPERSONAL AND INTERPERSONAL LEARNERS ON VARIOUS LEVELS

DESCRIPTION

Narrative-based teaching methods are those in which people define their lived experiences within the context of a story being told which helps them frame and understand their perception of the world.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR IN-PERSON TEACHING

- Establish an in-door location that offers physical accessibility to all group members and private to insure no interruptions.
- Adequate space for socially-distant sitting and/or standing for study activities.
- One to two hours of independent study of the selected Scripture and preparation.
- Gather materials and/or supplies needed for that week's gathering: visual aids, handouts, etc.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VIRTUAL TEACHING

- Follow the instructions for in-person teaching.
- Provide on-line participants with visual aids/handouts prior to class.
- Provide on-line participants with Zoom link prior to class.

IDEAS FOR USING THIS METHOD

- To validate the student's experience through expressing self-empathy and empathy for others
- To engender student-teacher connectivity while in the classroom
- To ascertain the student's perspective and how they form and understand their perspectives in the world
